This certifies that _____, here referred to as Mare Owner, has engaged one service to the following stallion, _____, standing at Whitacre QH & Paints, herein referred to as "Service Provider", subject to the following conditions. The breeding season for this contract will begin February 1 and close July 1, _____. A photostatic copy of the registration papers will be provided to the Service Provider prior to service.

The mare to be bred is: _____ Reg. No. _____ Breed _____.

A. CONDITIONS: A non-refundable booking fee of \$_____ is due at signing and acceptance of this contract. The balance of the stud fee in the amount of \$_____ is payable prior to semen being shipped (if serviced by Transported Cooled Shipped Semen). If the mare is brought to the Service Provider's for service, the balance of the Stud fee is due when the mare is checked thirty days in foal or prior to departure, whichever is first.

a. Transported Cooled Shipped Semen

1. Prior to shipment \$200 is due for shipments requesting Next Day Delivery within the United States (Canadian shipments \$250).
2. All requests for transported cool shipped semen shall be filled as received, subject to availability of semen, and at the sole discretion of the Service Provider. It is hereby understood that mares located at the Service Provider's will be serviced first.
3. Semen is collected every other day and the mare owner/agent must contact the Service Provider by 7 AM Central Time of the day semen is to be shipped. The mare owner should contact the Service Provider prior to the mare needing service to obtain the days collections are performed.

b. Mares brought to Whitacre QH & Paints for Service:

1. The Service Provider requires 1 day notice when the Mare Owner intends to remove the mare(s) from the Service Provider's facility. Veterinary expenses may be directly billed to the Mare Owner by the attending veterinarian. The balance of any outstanding debt owned to the Service Provider or the attending veterinarian(s) shall be paid in full before the mare departs.
2. The Mare Owner or Agent will provide a complete health certificate upon arrival: uterine culture, negative Coggins, worming schedule, current immunization records. Service Agent reserves the right to have said mare inspected and treated, at the mare owner's expense, if these articles are not provided. Mares must be halter broken and in sound breeding condition.

B. Waiver Of Liability: The Service Provider agrees to diligently try to settle the mare and shall have sole discretion of determining the best method of breeding such mare. If, however, the mare does not settle, the Service Provider shall be held harmless. It is understood that the Service Provider/Stallion Owner, employees, veterinarian(s), or guests shall not be liable for any injury, escape, disability, or death of any horse on its premises. Both Service Provider and Mare Owner agree that participation in equine activities hold an inherent risk.

C. Rebreds: All rights of return of service to the stallion are subject to the prepayment of costs listed in Item A the year before. There is a live colored foal guarantee. Mare owner understands the re-breed will be the following year.

D. Live Foal Guarantee: Live foal means the foal shall stand and nurse. Proper notification is as follows: If the mare is examined to be in foal but becomes barren during gestation, the Mare Owner will provide a veterinarian's certificate stating barrenness within seven days. If the mare produces a dead foal or a live

nonviable foal that is unable to stand alone and nurse, the Mare Owner will provide a veterinarian's certificate within seven days of the date of death.

E. It is further agreed that should the above named stallion die or become unfit for service this contract shall become null and void. In the event, the Mare Owner has paid the Stallion Service fees, the Mare Owner may breed the above named mare to another stallion at the Service Provider's that is agreed to by both the Mare Owner and the Stallion Provider. If the above named mare dies during the breeding season then the Mare Owner may substitute another mare that is agreed to by both the Mare Owner and Stallion Provider.

F. A Breeder's Certificate will be issued to the Mare Owner after all expenses have been paid in full (including veterinary services) and upon notification of the birth of the foal.
